<u>Genomes2Veterans (G2V)</u> published their latest paper about the <u>Genomic Medicine at Veterans</u> <u>Affairs (GenoVA) study</u> in which they evaluate the clinical utility of implementing polygenic risk scores (PRS) in primary care. They will investigate whether the use of PRS shortens time to diagnose patients with various health conditions and impacts what additional tests physicians order.
